An Election Reminder From The Texas Municipal Courts Association President

Dear TMCA member,

Our electronic candidate and bylaws amendment election is nearly over. Ballots must be cast by June 15th to count. To vote, you must log into our website at www.txmca.com. To log on to the website, your membership profile must have a discrete email address and a currently valid password. Once you log in, you will be prompted for your account email and password. If you are unable to login or have password issues, please [contact us](#) so that you can access your ballot.

The Board of Directors decided to conduct an election electronically to reach a greater number of members and to make it easier for members to vote. Your vote determines who represents you on the Board of Directors and therefore affects various policy decisions including **strategy for the upcoming legislative session, bylaws amendments, the annual meeting, allocation of membership dues funds, and issues with our building which houses the TMCEC.**

You will be able to select only one candidate for each position on the ballot. All members can cast their vote for President Elect, Second Vice President and Treasurer. Members from Regions II, IV, VI, VIII and X will also cast their vote for Directors in their respective region. If you want to learn more about the candidates prior to casting your vote, please visit the candidates' page.

Once your ballot is submitted, you will not be able to change your vote. Members will be allowed to submit only one ballot. Your ballot will be submitted anonymously. You will see a summary of your vote displayed once submitted. This is the only confirmation you will receive. We encourage you print this page for your records because you **will not** receive another confirmation of your vote. Results of the candidate elections will be certified by the Nominating Committee to the TMCA Board of Directors no later than June 30th.

If you have not voted yet, please vote now so that your voice can be heard.
